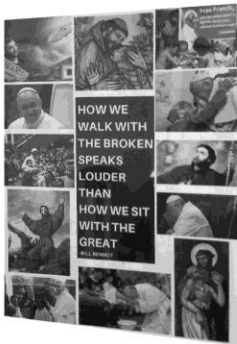


Do you ever have a desire to help others, but you don't know how?
